Description

Guide-it Recombinant Cas9 (3 µg/µl) is a recombinant wild-type *Streptococcus pyogenes* Cas9 nuclease expressed with a C-terminal nuclear localization signal (NLS). The Cas9 protein solution has been verified to be sterile and well-tolerated by mammalian cells when electroporated as a ribonucleoprotein complex (RNP) with a single guide RNA (sgRNA) for knockout experiments, or as an RNP with a donor repair template for knockin experiments.

Quality Control Data

Functional test

150 ng of recombinant Cas9 was tested in an in vitro cleavage experiment with a control sgRNA on a control PCR fragment. The recombinant Cas9, sgRNA, and PCR fragment were incubated at 37°C for 1 hr and a gel was run to verify that there was greater than 85% cleavage efficiency.

Sterility Test

There was no evidence of bacterial or fungal growth after inoculation into tryptic soy broth and thioglycolate broth.
